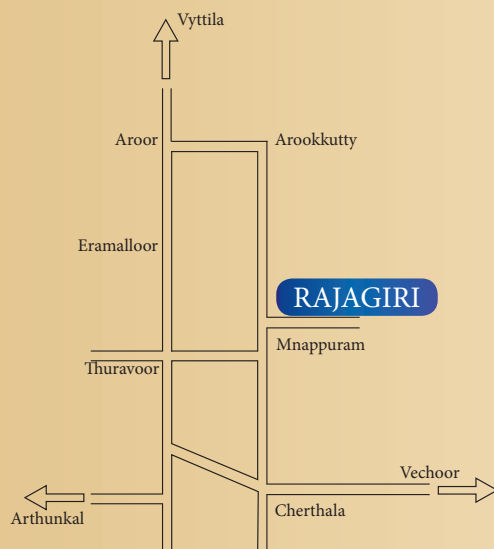

History in brief & Location



Rajagiri L F Kindergarten was the first initiative of the Little Flower Monastery, Manappuram of the CMI Congregation in the year 2012 and after one year founded Rajagiri St. Chavara CMI Public School in the year 2013. In accordance with the rules and regulations of the government for establishing and administering this school, the Monastery took the initiative to create a Trust Deed called Rajagiri St. Chavara CMI Public school Trust [Reg.No.50/14/IV dated 4.11.2014].

The school is housed in a sophisticated building. Class rooms are spacious and properly ventilated, furnished with comfortable furniture and smart classrooms. The school has fully equipped Science, Maths, Computer labs, well stocked library with internet facility, Art, craft, Dance, music rooms, multipurpose room, auditorium, conference room, basketball, football, volley ball and tennis courts, and spacious space for sports and games.

The school is ideally located in an extravagant ambience of natural beauty spreading over an area of 1 hectare 21 Ares of land at Manappuram, Thykattusery Grama Panchayath, Cherthala Taluk, Alappuzha District. - The medium of instruction is in English. Hindi and Malayalam and computer science are taught from Class1 onwards.

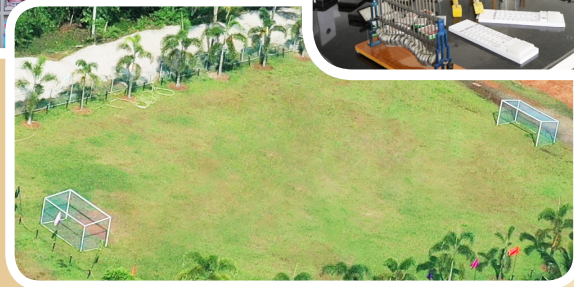
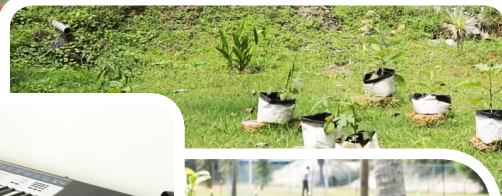
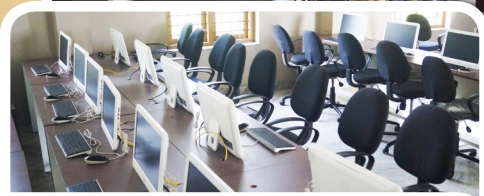
Admission of Students

A student seeking admission to LKG & class 1 should complete 3 years 7 months and 5 years 7 months of age respectively as on 1st June of the year in which the admission is sought.
